WEIMARANER CLUB OF SCOTLAND - CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW - 13TH NOVEMBER, 2011

Congratulations to the Committee of this Club in staging a well organised Show which had good atmosphere throughout the day. I enjoyed my first CC appointment for this breed and found the Open Bitch class very difficult to split. It was good to find that most exhibits had good muscle tone and movement in general was precise.

DOGS:

Minor Puppy 3 (1abs) 1. Sturrock's – Magregor Mohaka. Just right for his age, not overdone in any way. Attractive masculine head. Good height to length proportions giving excellent balance. Super forehand construction. Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Good bone and general substance. Well developed hindquarters with strong hocks which he used to advantage. Moved with good forward reach but when it came to challenge for BP I considered that the bitch was more together on the move. Very promising. 2. Bannerman's – Minama Roamin Down Under. Attractive head with good shaped expressive eye. Good bone and feet. Presents a very balanced picture. Quite mature for his age. Slightly over-angulated hindquarters. Good topline when standing but on the move he is slightly roaching his back. True movement fore and aft.

Puppy 3 (1abs) 1. Minama Roamin Down Under. 2. Maskell & Rayner's – Gunalt Distinction for Brownbank. Longer cast than 1. Pleasing head with intelligent expression. Good reach of neck and lay of shoulder. Straight front with good bone. Well developed hindquarters. Moved freely.
Very attentive to handler.

Junior 2 (0abs) 1. Rooney's – Flitnel's Kawasaki King at Zeatana. Filled my eye for his balance and strength. Good overall shape with height to length proportions to match. Nice flow into the withers. Shoulders well laid back. Seep in brisket. Strong topline. Well angulated rear. Moved positively with good head carriage. Gained his JW today. Should have a bright future.

2. Hendry's – Hollieseast The Time Lord. A bit too tall for his length making him look unbalanced.

Good head with kind expression. Could do with better lay back of shoulder. Correct earset. Strong topline and hocks. Moved soundly in both directions but elbows could be a little tighter.

Yearling 3 (0abs) 1. Flitnel's Kawasaki King at Zeatana. 2. Halliday's – Greyspirit Olympic Flame.

Good size but not quite together yet. Pleasing head with good earset. Expressive head-piece.

Sloping shoulders with deep brisket. Strong over the loin. Well angulated rear. Handler has to find the correct pace as it's not the 100 metre dash.

Novice 1 (0abs) 1. Hollieseast The Time Lord.

Graduate 2 (0abs) 1. Flitnel's Kawasaki King at Zeatana. 2. Young's – Brackenmist Storm Breaker.

A bit cloddy and didn't help his outline by roaching his back. Masculine head with intelligent eye and expression. Good reach of neck. Strong bone with good feet. Made life difficult for his handler. Has to settle on the move.

Post Graduate 3 (0abs). Rintoul's – Silverstern Water Buoy. Good size with balanced outline. Attractive, masculine head with a sign of coarseness. Neck flowing nicely into the withers. Good bone and feet. Mature deep body. On occasions a little careless with topline whilst standing. Well developed hindquarters with good width of thigh. Very attentive to handler. Held his shape well on the move and used his strong hocks to drive from the rear.

2. Turner's – Quadet Dargo at Rockleyan JW. Not so mature as 1 but preferred his size to 3. Good head with intelligent expression. Expressive eye. Correct earset. Strong topline which he held on the move. Moved freely but would like more muscle tone. 3. Thwaites @ Woodwards-Thwaites – Gunalt Harris Hawk.

Limit 9 (1abs) 1. Walker's Ansona Monsoon. He is all dog. Possesses good balance and substance.

Liked his attitude. Attractive head with intelligent expression. |Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Enhanced forehead. Deep in brisket. Strong feet and pasterns. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. Well let down hocks. Excels on the move and holds his strong topline.

Very stylish. 2. Clarke's – Sireva The Italian Job For Coastedge ShCm. Not as big as 1 but balanced throughout. Good length of shoulder blade. Not overdone in any way. In hard condition. Well developed hindquarters with strong hocks. Covered the ground with ease. Preferred head of 1.

3. Dixon's – Robricci Alfie Romeo JW.

Open 12 (1abs). 1. Stafford & Casey's – Sh.Ch. NZ. Ch Carnmellis Hot Dikkety Dog At Gunalt (Imp NZ). On going over him I thought he was carrying a little too much over the back but when he came to move I realised it was all muscle. He excels on the move which is effortless and he holds himself together so well and has the style to finish it off. Super outline. Excellent forehead construction with well developed hindquarters to match. No exaggerations in any form.

Strong feet and pasterns. Firm topline. Excellent forward reach and superb drive from his strong hocks. Could go all day. CC and RBIS. 2. Dyer's – Sh.Ch. Sharnphilly Awesome JW. Quality from nose to tail. Balanced throughout without a trace of coarseness. Loved his head and expression which is so typical. Super layback and upper arm. Well ribbed body. Strong bone and feet. Presented in tip-top condition. Moved with great purpose and carried his head well. RCC.

3. Whitehead's – Sh.Ch. Gunalt – De Ice At Stridview.

BITCHES:

Veteran 2 (0abs) 1. Robson's – Robricci Rose Royce JW Sh.Cm. - Excellent breed type. Possesses great balance. Showing no sign of her 7 years. Feminine head with alert expression. Good angles at both ends. Strong topline held on the move. Stylish mover. Loved her attitude. BVIS.

2. MacLaine & Dickson – Ir Sh Ch Tasairgid Real Neat With Greyspirit Sh.Cm. 9 year old and still full of it. Seemed to be enjoying her day. Lovely head with intelligent eye. Superb forehand. Short in couplings. Slightly low in tail-set. Tight fitting elbows and feet. Held her topline on the move. Loved her attitude.

Minor Puppy 7 (0abs) 1. Dawson's – Sireva Skipping. Didn't think she would be my winner early in the class but the more I looked at her the more I liked her. She was playing up a bit but every so often I would get a glimpse of the qualities she possessed. Beautiful, feminine head with kind expression. Good size and balance. Reachy neck flowing into well laid back shoulders. Strong topline and well developed hindquarters. Sound movement in both directions but not quite at one with her handler. Very promising. 2. Carpenter's – Aschfahl Isen. Quality puppy who just lost her topline at a crucial stage in the class and had to pay the penalty. Good breed type who has balance and style. Sweet feminine head. Good feet and bone. Wide thighs and good bend of stifle. Strong hocks which she used to drive on the move. Moving slightly wide in front but this should tighten with maturity. Nicely put together. 3. Rowbury's – Stormdancer Plan Bee.

Puppy 7 (0abs) 1. Elders and Wards – Gunalt Gorjuss. Yes gorgeous she is. Good height to length proportions which gives her balance. Excellent overall shape and she has the elegance to go with it.

Sweet, feminine head with good work in it. Everything is in proportion. Good angles at both ends

with mature body in between. Movement is totally co-ordinated with excellent forward reach and

great drive from strong hocks. Very stylish. BPIS. 2. Gibbons & Gilberts - Gunalt Socialite at Telleara. Litter sister to 1. Quite similar remarks apply but she is smaller and longer in loin than sister.

Moved an absolute dream. Two quality puppies full of promise. 3. Aschfahl Isen.

Junior 7 (0abs) 1. Hawkins – Enryb Party Surprise for Sagunto JW. Liked her shape and size to go with

her overall balance. Sweet head and expression. Nice flow of neck into the withers. Good straight

front with tight fitting elbows. Deep in brisket. Well ribbed body. Well developed hindquarters which she used to advantage to drive on the move. Good forward reach.

Excellent breed type.

2. Rayner's – Gunalt The Look at Raystans. Elegant and feminine throughout. Attractive head with intelligent expression. Good forehand construction. Pasterns could be stronger. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. Strong over the loin. Moved on balanced strides. 3.

Clarke's – Errytar Elegance.

Yearling 2 (0abs) 1. Hollings – Gunalt Perceive. Presents a balanced outline. Beautiful head with kind expression. Would like more lay back and upper arm. Well ribbed body. Wide thighs and strong hocks. Strong topline held on the move. Covered the ground well with strong hind action.

2. Errytar Elegance. Would like a little more confidence. Pleasing head . Elbows a little loose. What I liked about her the most was her true, positive movement.

Novice 2 (0abs) 1. Aschfahl Isen. 2. Moragn's – Parhelis Siona. Needs more time to fill out and come together. Would prefer better layback of shoulder and more upper arm. Good bone and feet. Well developed hindquarters. Sweet, feminine head with kind expression. Moved OK.

Graduate 3 (1abs). White & Scougall's – Silverkelvin Rising Star. Won on size and balance and overall quality. A bit unsettled. Pleasing head. Would prefer to see better layback of shoulder and more upper arm. Strong topline and body properties. Strong feet and pasterns. Moved Ok but no great flow to her movement. 2. Rickett's – Stormdancer Wanna Be Adored. Smaller than 1 and lacking in style. Fine in head and bone. Carrying too much weight over the back. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. Moved truly in both directions.

Post Graduate 5 (1abs) 1. Robson's – Robricci Audrey Quattro. Quality from nose to tail without a trace of exaggerations. Lovely head with alert, intelligent expression. Good forehead with hindquarters to match. Strong bone and feet. Moved freely and with style. Good head carriage. Liked her a lot.

2. Gibbons and Gilberts – Jolenoo Peaches N Cream. Not quite the head or expression of 1. Liked her size. Deep in brisket. Strong over the loin. Mature body in good hard condition. Excelled on the move which was effortless. 3. Kirk's – Kirlivada Sweet Tummel Lily.

Limit 10 (2abs) 1. Simpson's – Sireva Firenze. Won this class on movement which was a joy to watch.

Think she could go all day. Super balance with no exaggerations. Good balanced head. Well placed shoulders. Strong topline. Well ribbed. Wide thighs with good bend of stifle. Good feet and pasterns. Excellent breed type. 2. Turner's – Enryb Bridal Party at Rockleyan JW. Taller than 1. Making life difficult for handler. Sweet, feminine head with good work in it. Well sprung ribs.

Would like to see stronger pasterns. Well developed hindquarters with strong hocks. Moved truly

and with purpose 3. Harding-Browns - Dreystone Nashira Chika.

Open 15 (4abs) 1. MacLaine & Dickson's – Ir Sh Ch Greyspirit Liberty Sh. Cm. Ticked the boxes for me and didn't put a foot wrong. The more that I looked at her the more I liked her. She is totally feminine without a trace of coarseness and has no exaggerations in any shape or form. Feminine and quality from nose to tail. Attractive head with kind expression. Good forehead construction. Strong topline. Moved with style on balanced free strides. Handler gets the best out of her . CC & BIS.

2. Elder's & Samria – Sh Ch & Ir.Ch Gunalt Delicious JW Sh.Cm. Well made throughout. Pleasing head with intelligent expression. Reachy neck with good flow into the withers. Good straight front with strong bone and tight feet. Balanced height to length proportions. Well developed hindquarters. Super effortless movement with strong drive. RCC. 3. Hollings – Gunalt Delightful.
